

COVID - Testing Offer for all Teams, Media, OC & World Rowing

Version 4.1 – e

1. Purpose and objective

This specifies the possibility for all Teams, World Rowing members, OC members and media to apply for and receive the necessary COVID-19 PCR tests in order to be allowed to travel to another country by air or other means, or to prepare for attendance at the World Rowing Cup II if the person is participating in both events.

Objective:

- ▶ To ensure that international participants of both regattas have the possibility to receive the necessary Covid-19 testing certificates necessary for their international travel
- ▶ That the OC can ensure the necessary test infrastructure and lab capacity to serve all applicants that have reserved such testing before April 30, 2021. Reservations thereafter are on a best offer basis.

2. Reservation – PCR Testing - Results

- ▶ The OC is organising an on-site Covid-19 PCR testing facility , which will be operated by Synlab company. Rapid tests will not be available at this facility. There is the following charge for the tests.
 - Covid-19 PCR Test CHF 170.00/€ 160.00 on site/individually → Results within 24h
 - Administration fee CHF 50.00 will be billed to the team in case of non-appearance or late appearance for a booked test.

Reservations are made via the Internet and can be paid in the accreditation tent by credit -, debit card or in cash. After payment, you will receive a voucher against which you can have your test performed at Synlab.

In the event of a no-show, i.e. if a valid reservation has been made and the respective person does not show up on time - i.e. within 5 minutes of the reservation time - the team will be charged an administration fee of CHF 50.00 by the OC.

- ▶ Other PCR and rapid tests can be booked at the public testing centers located close to the event location for instance at the railway station in the center of Lucerne. (see below) Transport can be arranged.

▶ **Reservation**

- Reservations must be made before April 30, 2021 for the FOQR and May 7, 2021 for WC II to ensure that you can get the test on site.

Reservations thereafter will be served on a best effort base.

- Find a free test slot and reserve it for yourself
- enter your home address, zip code and place of residence under remarks
- Fill in the details completely and finalise the reservation
- You will then receive a confirmation e-mail

▶ **Prepayment**

- Prior to the reserved testing you will have to pay the test at the accreditation center. This can be one payment for one or for several tests (same opening hours as the accreditation center).
- You will receive one voucher which for each test purchased.

▶ Testing

- Be at the Testing Centre on time for the reserved appointment and report to Synlab. Bring the accreditation card and personal identification (ID card or passport) so that you can identify yourself. Give Synlab the test voucher to receive your test. Reserve 15 minutes for testing.

▶ Test result

- The test results are communicated by e-mail, SMS or in writing within a maximum of 24 hours. If it is done in writing, the test result can be collected during the opening hours of the test centre, afterwards, at the accreditation center against presentation of the accreditation batch or a personal identification (identity card or passport).
- If the test result is positive, the CO and the CTO will be contacted personally by the event doctor and the procedure for Covid-19 infected team members will be followed. Re-entry into the boat storage area is strictly prohibited, also staying at the Rotsee is not allowed.

 - Sunday, 23 May 08:00 – 12:00

RETRIEVE ELECTRONIC LAB REPORT

1. You will receive an email as soon as the lab report is available.
2. Click on «laboratory report» and the patient portal will be opened in your browser.
3. Click «Request an smsTAN». You will receive an SMS on your cell phone (to the phone number you have stated during the sampling).
In case you are abroad, you need to activate data roaming, to receive the SMS.
4. Enter the TAN from the SMS to the corresponding field in the patient portal and click "OK".
5. Your test will be displayed. Click on the download symbol to display the lab report.
6. The lab report will be opened as PDF.
