

## COVID – Rules and Specifications for all TEAMS

### 1. Purpose and objective

These specifications regulate the duties and obligations for all the TEAMS during and after the Final Olympia Qualifications Regatta (FOQR) and the World Rowing Cup II (WRC). The duty specification is considered as a guideline and must be complied with at all times. The instructions of world rowing, the OC and its volunteers are to be observed and followed strictly. Non-compliance or failure to follow the instructions and requirements will result in a ban from the site.

#### Objective:

- ▶ Ensure that, in accordance with the recommendations of the [FOPH](#) and the local authorities, the event can be staged without incidence.
- ▶ That TEAMS comply with applicable protective measures and regulations, especially the compliance with the applicable [rules of hygiene and conduct](#)
- ▶ Prevent the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus and break transmission chains.

### 4. Duty to inform

TEAMS must register all members in advance for accreditation by world rowing/OC. TEAM members who are not accredited have no access to the event area.

TEAM members who develop symptoms of the disease must be reported immediately to the Covid-Officer of the OC. Furthermore, the affected person must immediately undergo a [PCR test](#) at a test facility selected by the Covid-Officer on or off site and behave according to the requirements of the FOPH. After receiving the test result, the Covid-Officer must be informed immediately so that any necessary measures can be taken.

### 5. Behavioral basics

- ▶ TEAM managers ensure:
- ▶ that their members are healthy and adhere to the current and applicable [measures](#) and [regulations](#);
- ▶ that the personal accreditation is worn visibly at all times and is presented at any control point without being asked;  
→ *This applies also to drivers and other personal transporting boats and other material. They have to get their accreditation before approaching the boathouse area for unloading.*
- ▶ that all TEAM members comply with the applicable [rules of hygiene and conduct](#)
- ▶ that cases of illness are reported immediately to the organizer and such persons are prevented to enter the event area;
- ▶ that affected TEAM members are complying with applicable instructions and behave according to the [instructions of the FOPH](#) and the Covid-Officer of the OC;

- ▶ that the time spent on the event site is kept as short as possible. TEAM members are requested to visit the area only for training sessions and races. The time spent on the event site before and after these activities is to be kept as short as possible.
- ▶ that TEAM members take the shortest/safest way to their accommodation and – if leaving their accommodation - take utmost care not to get in contact with third parties.

#### 6. Special

It should be noted that the freedom of movement is limited throughout the event area. TEAM members are only allowed to the boathouse zone. TEAM Members are not allowed to spend time at the Rotsee other than in the accredited event zone. TEAM members who are seen at the Rotsee outside the accredited boathouse zone will be expelled and reported. The right to impose sanctions on TEAM members who violate the rules is reserved.

The access controls will be carried out strictly, the personnel of the access control and supervision services will be instructed not to make any exceptions. The instructions of the organizer's staff must be followed.

It should be noted that short-term accreditations will not always be possible. It is to be expected that at times the accreditation bodies may be overloaded.
